Your child's Provisional Results

You will receive by email on **Monday 21 June 2021** the Provisional Results for all of the courses your child has been studying this session.

During this year, when the Alternative Certification Model has been in place, all of the assessment and marking processes within the school have undergone three levels of scrutiny to arrive at the final results. These are:

- 1. Moderation and verification in school, involving all teachers in the department or faculty
- 2. Moderation and verification outwith school, with two allocated partner schools in Glasgow.
- 3. Further review by Glasgow City Council data teams

Following the issue of Provisional Results on Monday 21 June, Pastoral Care staff and Year Heads will be available in the school cafeteria on **Tuesday 22 June** to meet with any pupil who wishes to discuss any of the results they have received. Please send your child to school on this date if they have any questions which they would like to ask about their results.

Appeals
